Motivational interviewing techniques have been evaluated and found to be effective in randomized clinical trials. These trials have examined the impact of the use of motivational interviewing to elicit behavior modification such as smoking cessation, human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) risk reduction, and increased diet and exercise 4 10 .

Clinical Interview Form: Please complete this form prior to your appointment. Although it is lengthy, it is important to obtain a clear and accurate developmental history of each client in order to understand his or her learning ability and behavior. It will also help us in formulating a remediation plan for him or her.
